Asian Pairs Bridge Championships 2026

We are excited to extend a warm invitation to your members from Zone 4 and Zone 6 to participate in the Asian Pairs Bridge Championships 2026, an official event sanctioned by the Asia Pacific Bridge Federation (APBF) and hosted by the Hong Kong, China Contract Bridge, with the Quanzhou Contract Bridge Association serving as the organizing body.

This year, we are delighted to share that the event will be relocated to Quanzhou, China, and held prior to the 3rd Maritime Silk Road Bridge Invitational Tournament, with the Quanzhou Contract Bridge Association providing full on-site support. Quanzhou, a historic city renowned for its rich cultural heritage and warm hospitality, offers an inspiring setting for this year's championships.
